We award three scholarships annually of \$ 1,000 each and these scholarships are renewable for one additional year with evidence of academic success.

All three scholarships adhere to the same guidelines and deadlines.

Requirements for Application

1. You must be a member, junior affiliate member, or a child or grandchild of a Connecticut Society of Mayflower Descendants member.
2. You must have confirmed plans to attend a college or university (provide a copy of letter of acceptance).
3. Academic achievement, extra-curricular involvement, and community service are considered in the review of each application.
- 4 The completed application and all required documentation must be received by the Scholarship Chairperson prior to March 1st.
5. Awards will be presented at the spring meeting of the Connecticut Society of Mayflower Descendants.

Please note that \$1,000 will be awarded for each of three renewable scholarships: the Mrs. Henry Griggs Isham Scholarship, the Bernice Andrews Livingston Reig Scholarship, and the Jordon Konov Scholarship. The monies will be disbursed at the start of the second semester of the first and second years. It is the recipient's responsibility to inform the Treasurer of their academic success and provide the information as to where the funds should be sent each year. This information will be included in your letter of acceptance.

- A complete transcript of secondary school record to date.
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher or school official.
- A letter of recommendation from a non-relative employer, if applicable.
- A letter of recommendation from a non-relative supervisor of any volunteer community activities, if applicable.
- An essay on one of the following themes:
 - How the Pilgrim experience resonates in today's society.
 - How my Pilgrim ancestor's life affects my life.
